## VIÑA PEDROSA RESERVA 2019

A powerful red that deserves full attention. Noble, elegant and lingering.

### DESCRIPTION

- Variety: 100% Tinto Fino (Tempranillo). Own vineyard.
- Goblet pruned / Age: Up to 50 years.
- Altitude: 840 m.
- Soil: clay - limestone.
- Harvest: by hand
- Ageing: 24 months in American and French oak barrels.
- Resting in bottle: minimum 12 months.
- Production: 60.720 bottles 75 cl.
- Bottling date: January 2022
- Alcohol content: 14,5 %

### TASTING NOTES

👁 Intense ruby red with brick red hues.

👃 A powerful and complex nose reminiscent of ripe black fruit and stewed plum and blackcurrant, with mineral and spiced aromas and light notes of truffle.

🍷 On the palate it is broad, sweet and elegant. Excellent structure, very fleshy and with a concentration of noble, enveloping tannins.



## CONSERVATION AND PREFERRED CONSUMPTION

Serving Temperature: 16-17 °C

12-15 years potential storage in optimal conditions of 13-14 °C and 60% relative humidity, without temperature fluctuations.

## VINTAGE 2019

We, winemakers, enjoy remembering each harvest: every vintage is unique and, at the same time, it is a challenge to overcome, because weather conditions we deal to are not always proper.

2019 harvest is one that we will never forget, it is such a 'great harvest'. One year more, the 'unwritten rule' about vintages ending in '9' is met again: every vintage ending in '9' is exceptional. Of course, 2019 vintage also is.

Pérez Pascuas Winery (Ribera del Duero) enjoyed a very nice 2019's harvest thanks to the weather: we could pick all the grapes before the typical autumn rains began.





During 2019, the cycle of the vine was characterized by a very cold and dry winter, that delayed the vine sprout.

Then, a hot and very dry summer with huge changes in temperature between day and night and some late summer rains, helped to balance the ripening of the grapes.

After a long year of hard work in the land, our vineyards have provided us a low production but a very high quality grapes.

We have obtained very complex and well structured wines, due to a high polyphenolic concentration. After ageing the wine in oak barrels and with a long rest in the bottle, we are sure that these wines will represent the essence of the Ribera del Duero.
