- Variety: 100% Tinto Fino (Tempranillo).

- Goblet pruned / Average age: 35 years.
- Altitude: 835 m.
- Soil: clay-limestone
- Harvest: by hand
- Ageing: 18 months in American and French oak barrels.
- Resting in bottle: minimum 6 months.
- Production: 320.000 bottles

TASTING NOTES

👁 Intense cherry red with purple rims.

👃 Suggestive and very expressive on the nose, aromas of berries stand out along with delicate aromas of ageing (vanilla, coffee, balsamic notes, toffee and Chinese ink).

🍷 On the palate it is broad, very rich, with nerve and succulent tannins. The aftertaste is intense and has a lingering finish.



CONSERVATION AND PREFERRED CONSUMPTION

Serving Temperature: 16-17 °C

8-10 years potential storage in optimal conditions of 13-14 °C and 60% relative humidity, without temperature fluctuations.

VINTAGE 2021

The year 2021 started with very cold temperatures, plentiful snowfalls, and abundant rains. This harvest is characterized by well-balanced grapes and an homogenous development on different parcels of the vineyard.

The cover crop was vital to counteract humidity and get an optimum balance in the vines. The vineyards developed with regularity as no special meteorological events were noticed during the rest of the year.

Thanks to the excellent job done by the vine growing team, the vegetative growth intensity was perfect and the grapes showed no diseases. The crop thinning done in the vines was also very important to get well-balanced grapes.

Harvest started at the beginning of October and the grapes picked were of an outstanding quality. The harvest of 2021 will always be remembered as one of the greatest vintages in the history of Viña Pedrosa. Wines of an exceptional quality and with a very long life ahead and a great ageing potential.
