

CEPA GAVILÁN CRIANZA 2022

As a crianza, this is the youngest wine made by the Pérez Pascuas family. It has all the strength and freshness of a Tinto Fino. It bravely defends its personality in the glass.

DESCRIPTION

- Variety: 100% Tinto Fino (Tempranillo). Own vineyard.
- Goblet pruned / Age: Over 20 years.
- Altitude: 840 m.
- Soil: clay.
- Harvest: by hand
- Ageing: minimum 12 months in American and French oak barrels.
- Resting in bottle: minimum 12 months.
- Production: 200.000 bottlesBottling date: December 2023
- Alcohol content: 14.5%

TASTING NOTES

- Intense cherry red with purple hues.
- Exuberant nose with a dominant presence of generous black fruit (blackberry and blueberry) over spice and mineral undertones.
- Oily and delicate with well-integrated ripe tannins. The aftertaste is intense and persistent and once again recalls fruity, vanilla and pastry aromas.



CONSERVATION AND PREFERRED CONSUMPTION

Serving Temperature: 16-17 °C

5 years potential storage in optimal conditions of 13-14 °C and 60% relative humidity, without temperature fluctuations.

VINTAGE 2022

Harvest 2022 was marked by very little rainfall and mild temperature. Thanks to water reserves from year before, the vineyard had a good phenological cycle. The vines development was a little bit earlier than 2021 and fortunately there was no hail atormentado and frost neither. Both sprouting and bloom were perfect and the vines development was well balanced. The lack of rain promoted good health during the spring. The summer was extremely hot but thanks to all the trees preserved and new trees planted over the years and also the perfect handle of cover crops, the vegetativedevelopmentwasoptimum. Theripeningwas slowerthanyears before.

The weather conditions were perfect during the harvest. It started September 22nd and finished October 12th. The 2022 vintage was very good but short on quantity. Wines from vintage 2022 will be long-lasting wines.

The regenerative grape-growing developed by Bodegas Hermanos Pérez Pascuas has made possible to get top quality grapes even do the year was so complicate for grapegrowers in Ribera del Duero
